If you are seeking a Final Placement and:

- Undertaking an **advanced level of counselling skills/training** at SQCF 9/10/11, or COSCA 'Advanced' courses (please note this is **NOT** HND or DipHE level). Normally:
  - Diploma in Counselling
  - PG Diploma in Counselling
  - MSC in Counselling
  - or equivalent
- Can commit to undertaking a volunteering role within Cruse Scotland and who can work within our organisational policies, such as our time limited support model and work with a minimum of two clients at any given time
- Have been trained by your course provider in delivery of therapeutic support and Counselling through telephone and/or digital means
- Provide your own counselling supervision across placement hours
- Commitment to attend and successfully complete our 2-day Digital 'Fast Track' training, **Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> September & Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> October 2023**, completion of pre training eLearning and induction session following training
- Interviews will be held week beginning **11<sup>th</sup> September 2023**.
