

Barclays Hampden Zip Slide T's and C's

1. Age Restrictions: You must be at least 12 years of age on the date of the event. Participants aged 12 - 17 years require a parent or legal guardian to be present at the event and to sign the waiver on the participant's behalf.

2. Safety Rules: Epic Xperience has instituted its Safety Rules for the protection of everyone attending the Zip Slide including participants. Please ensure that your participants follow the Safety Rules and any instructions given.

- If they have long hair, please be prepared to tie it up and out of the way
- Minimum participant weight is 35 kg (5.5 stone)
- Maximum participant weight is 120 kg (18.9 stone)
- Waist harnesses fit waist size of 40 cm (15.7 inches) to 120 cm (47.2 inches)
- not wear any necklaces, chains or loose jewellery
- wear sensible footwear fastened securely
- not adjust or remove the harness once fitted
- not carry loose items
- act responsibly and courteously at all times
- listen carefully and follow instructions from instructors at all times
- not be under the influence of alcohol or non-prescription drugs
- have no known medical or other conditions that would affect safe participation (inc. pregnancy), or that would result in a risk of danger to yourself or to others.

It is your participants' responsibility to monitor their physical and mental health on the lead up to and during the zipslide. If they have any doubts about their physical fitness or health, it is their responsibility to consult with a qualified medical professional before taking part.

Failure to adhere to these Safety Rules, participation in the zipslide may be denied without any liability to you by Epic Xperience.

3. All participants knowingly and freely assume and accept all such risks and take full responsibility for their participation in the event and Chest Heart & Stroke Scotland, its employees or agents will not be liable for any loss, damage, action, claim, costs or expenses, which may arise in consequence of participation in the event.

4. All participants will be required to complete a Participation Agreement form on the day of the event and will also be weighed as a safety precaution. It is responsibility for each charity to ensure each participant knows to visit the registration desk on arrival.

If this event was cancelled prior to the event date, we would endeavor to reschedule this event rather than offer refunds.

8. Should your charity have to withdraw or cannot fulfil your places there will be no refund payable.

9. Each charity will deal with their own registration fees and fundraising for participants before, throughout and after the event..

10. All participants are responsible for their personal belongings during the event. The event organisers and instructors will not be held liable for any loss, theft, or damage to personal property.
